



Weekly Commentary

-U.S. markets ended the week lower following trade worries amid President Trump's announcement of new trade restraints against China. This week, the DJIA fell by 5.7%, the S&P sunk by 6.0%, and the NASDAQ decreased by 6.5%.

-In energy news, crude oil futures increased 5.7% to close the week at \$65.88 per barrel amid renewed signs that OPEC look to maintain production curb into 2019. Natural gas fell 3.6% to close at \$2.59 per mmbtu, as the Energy Information Administration reported a decrease of 86 bcf to approximately 1.446 trillion cubic feet for the week ended March 16. Analysts were expecting a decline of 87 bcf.

-In U.S. economic news, Durable orders, excluding transportation, for February read at 1.2%, reversing from January's upwardly-revised 0.2% decline and above estimates of 0.6%. Separately, the current account balance for Q4 reported a \$128.2 billion deficit, below both the prior-quarter's downwardly-revised \$101.5 billion deficit and estimates of \$125.0 billion deficit. In housing news, the MBA mortgage applications index for the week fell 1.1%, below the prior-week's 0.9% gain. Meanwhile, existing home sales for February came in at 5.54M, ahead of January's 5.38M reading and above consensus estimates of 5.42M. New home sales for the same month came in at 618,000, below both the prior-month's upwardly-revised 622,000 and consensus estimates of 620,000. Additionally, the FHFA housing price index for January came in at 0.8%, besting both estimates and the prior-period's upwardly-revised 0.4%. Elsewhere, February durable orders came in at 3.1%, higher than both the prior-period's upwardly-revised 3.5% decline and economists' estimates of 1.5%. In labor news, initial claims for the week came in at 229,000, up from the prior-week's 226,000 and also higher than economists' estimates of 225,000. Continuing claims for week ended March 10 came in at 1,828,000, below the prior-week's upwardly-revised 1,885,000. Finally, leading indicators, for February were reported as 0.6%, missing January's downwardly-revised 0.8%, and above economists' estimates of 0.5%.

-In corporate news, FedEx, Micron Technology, Five Below, Accenture, Cheetah Mobile and General Mills beat earnings estimates. Meanwhile, Oracle, Children's Place, Darden Restaurants, Actuant and ConAgra issued mixed earnings results. In M&A news, General Dynamics Corporation said that it raised its offer for CSRA Inc. to \$9.70 billion, including \$2.80 billion in debt, in an attempt to top an unsolicited bid from CACI International Inc.

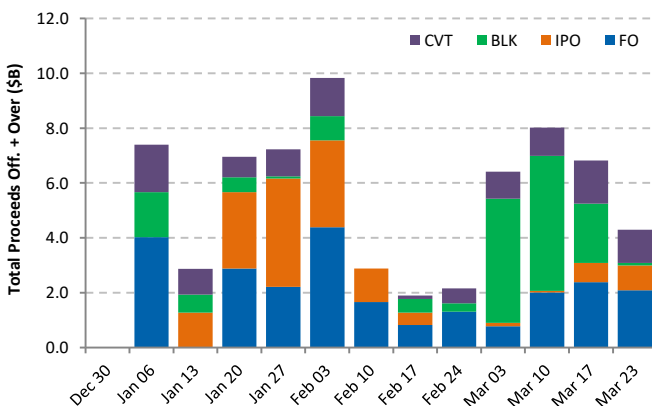

Trailing U.S. New Issuance by Deal Type

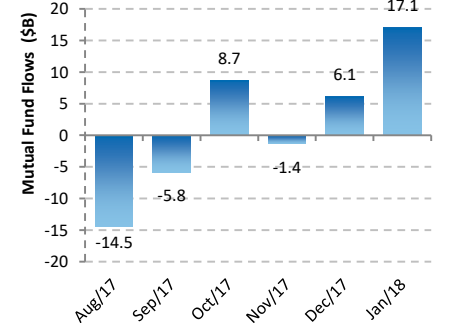

New Issuance Recap:

As March Madness continued with Loyola-Chicago's improbably run into the Elite Eight, the new issuance market welcomed 20 deals (2 IPOs, 11 FOs, 1 BLK, and 6 CVT) to the market for \$4.3B in combined proceeds. The largest IPO of the week came from the highly anticipated debut of cloud-storage provider, Dropbox, Inc., which generated \$756.0M. Dropbox marks the second largest Technology of the year behind PagSeguro Digital Ltd.'s \$2.3B debut out of Brazil in January. Meanwhile, Sunlands Online Education Group's IPO was the sole deal to emerge from Asia this week, being domiciled in China and raised \$149.5M. Separately, 11 fully marketed follow-on deals priced this week for a total of \$2.1B in proceeds. Wynn Resorts set the pace with the largest deal of the week, after bringing in an impressive \$927.5M in proceeds. The casino operator out-earned the next highest follow-on issuer, Arena Pharmaceuticals (\$352.8M), by nearly \$575.0M. In addition, the follow-on category contained the only two other foreign deals for the week, as Cronos Group Inc. (Canada) and DBV Technologies S.A. (France) earned \$100.0M and \$59.2M, respectively. The lone block deal of the week was brought to market by Akebia Therapeutics and pulled together just \$89.3M. The six convertible deals that priced last week were led by Herbalife Ltd.'s \$550.0M offering from the Consumer Services sector. Elsewhere, Blackstone Mortgage Trust, Inc. yielded \$220.0M in proceeds and was the only other convertible deal to break the \$200.0M mark. Looking ahead to this week, the new issuance is expecting six IPOs \$3.3B in proceeds. The eye catcher of the week is iQIYI, Inc., a Chinese provider of entertainment services, which expects to garner proceeds of \$2.3B. If the company hits their target, iQIYI, Inc. will have the largest IPO of a Chinese domiciled company since Alibaba Group Holding Ltd. amassed a whopping \$25.0B in September of 2014.
